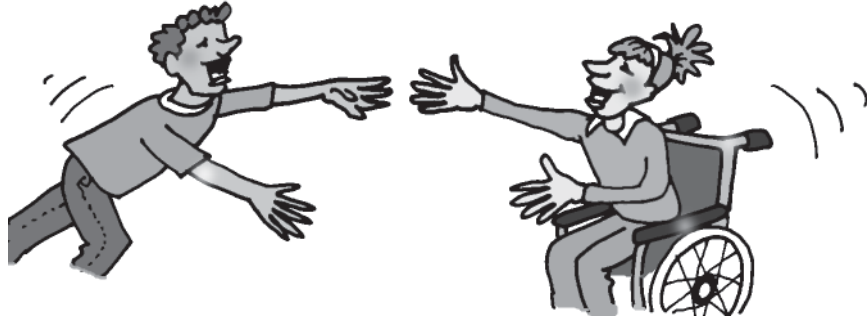

in the office.

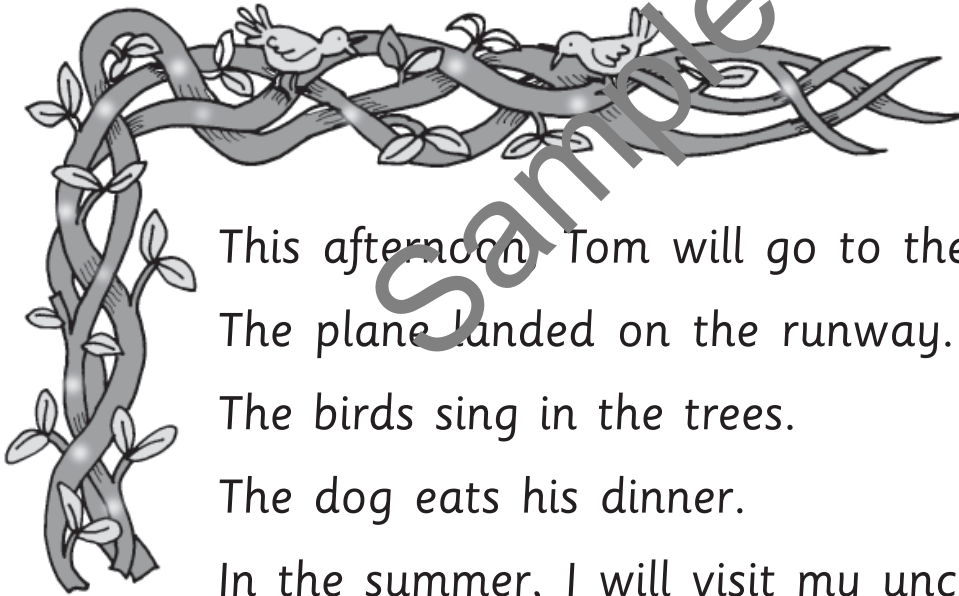
This verb is in

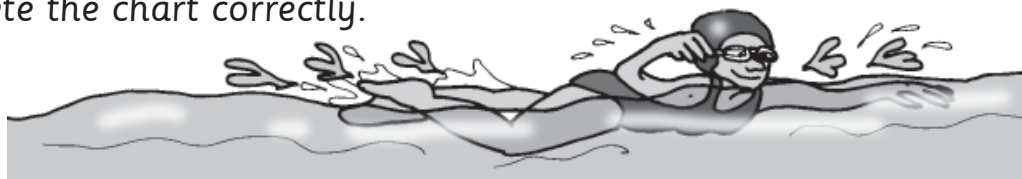

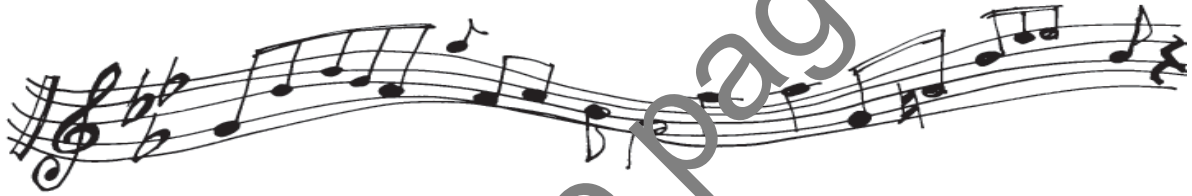
