Estelle put a big cloth round her.

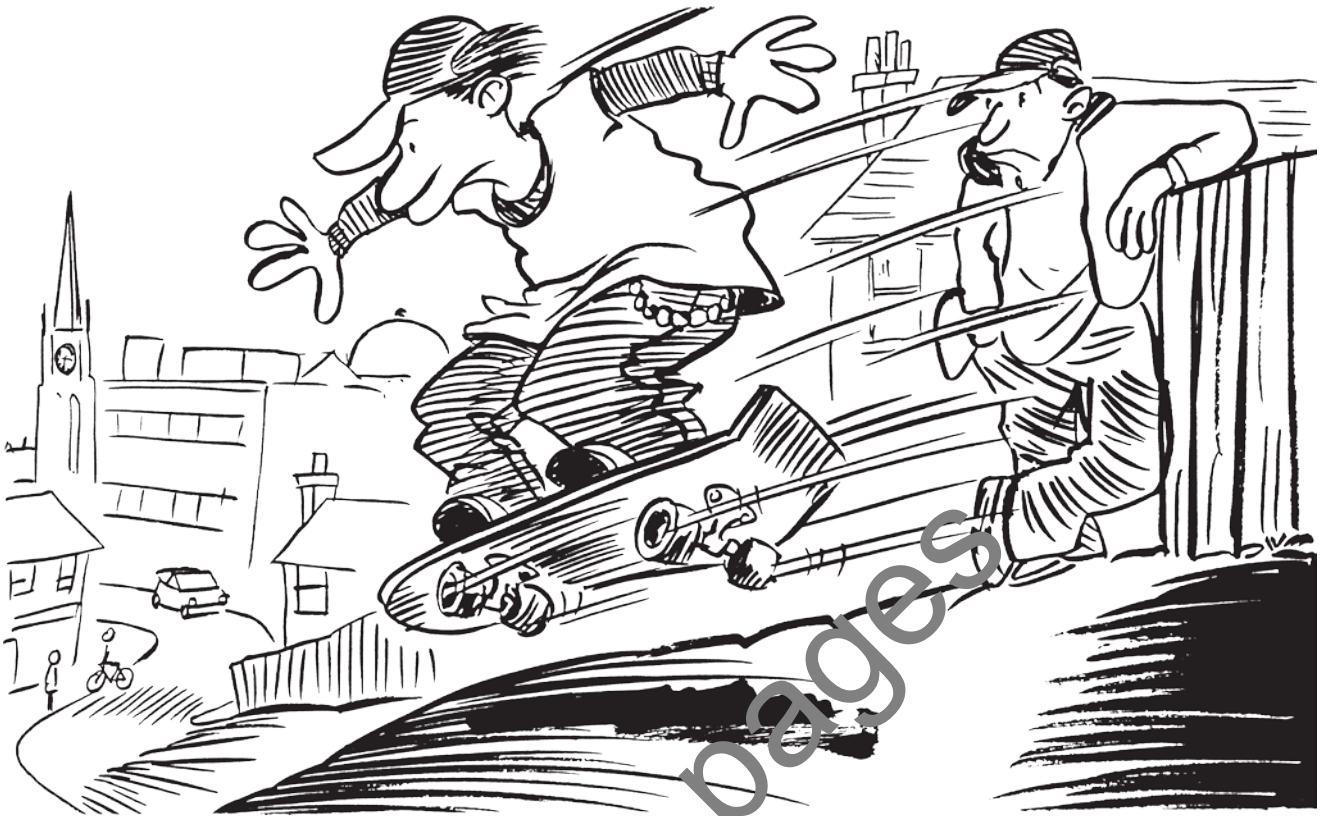
She sat down in the chair.

Runaway!



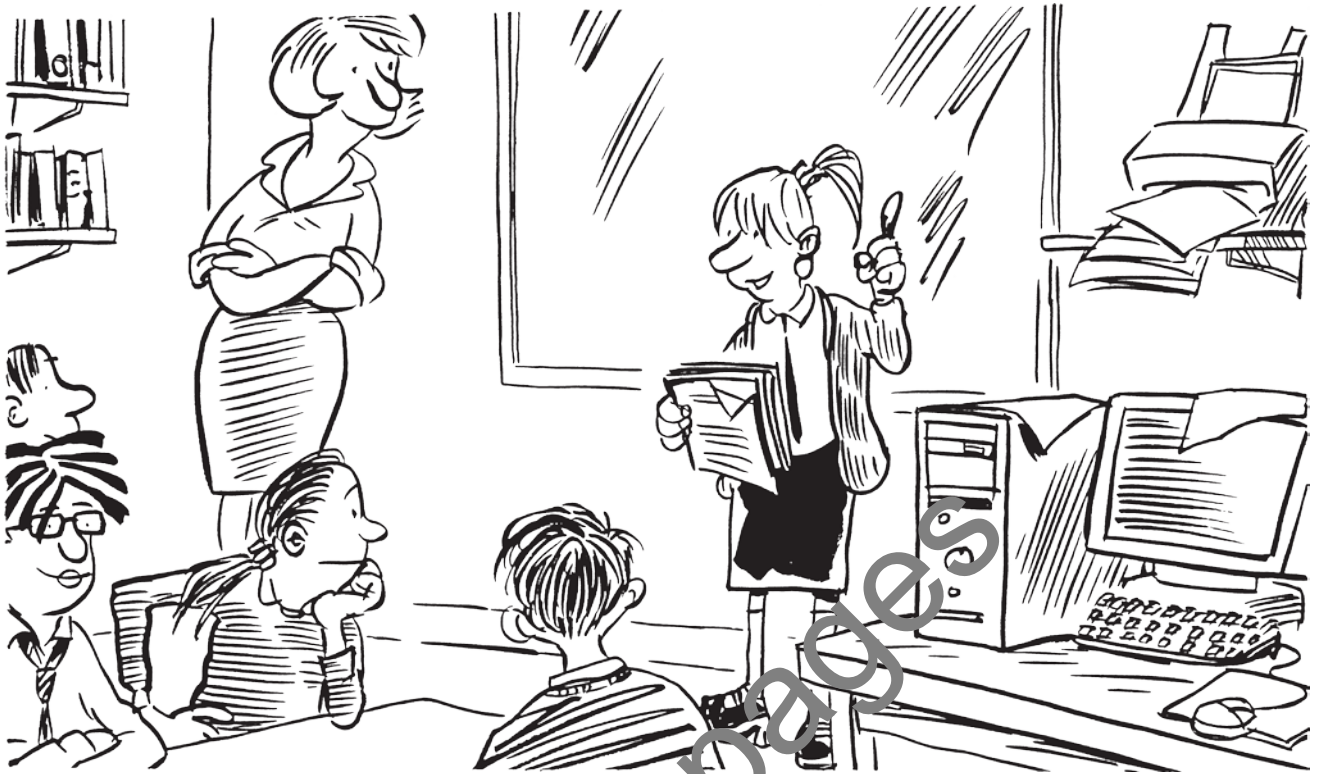
It shot off down the street with

He put it down on the pavement.



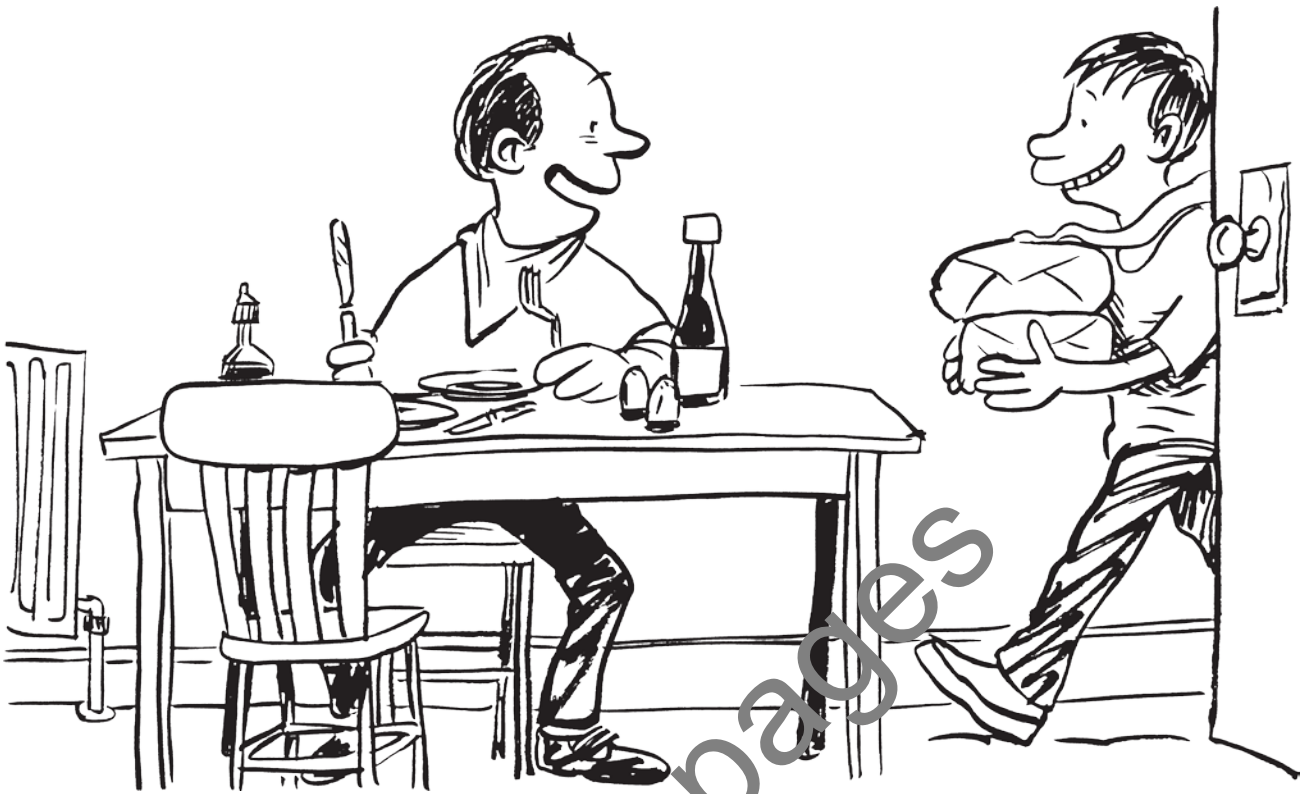
All the children listened to her story.
